

ORDINANCE # 01-18

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE MOST PUBLIC PLACES IN THE CITY SUFFICIENT FOR POSTING OF ORDINANCES; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City Council of the city of Highland, Arkansas to publish all bylaws or ordinances of a general or permanent nature and all those imposing any fine, penalty, or forfeiture, and,

WHEREAS, no newspaper is published, in the city of Highland, Arkansas,

WHEREAS, as A.C.A. 14-55-206 provides that municipalities in which no newspaper is published, written or printed; notice posted in five (5) of the most public places designated by the governing body in an ordinance or minutes of the governing body shall be deemed a sufficient publication of any law or ordinance,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the city of Highland, Arkansas,

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the city of Highland, Arkansas, hereby designates the following as the most public places for the posting of all bylaws or ordinances of a general or permanent nature:

1. Town & Country Foods
2. Red Mule
3. Timberline Restaurant
4. Randy's Pharmacy
5. Hill's Drug Store

SECTION 2. Whereas the city can save many dollars by posting ordinances in five (5) places and whereas this is now permitted by A.C.A. 14-55-206, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance, being necessary for the immediate protection of the public, peace, health, safety and welfare shall take effect on its passage and posting.

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE # 01-18


**AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE MOST PUBLIC PLACES IN THE CITY

The City of Highland, Arkansas, on this 27th day of May, 2003 is hereby amending ordinance # 01-18 on the posting in five (5) most public places the six (6) month financial statement. The financial statement will from this day forward be published in one local newspaper twice a year.


The financial statement, for the first six (6) months of the calendar year, shall be published by September first (1). The financial statement for the last six (6) months of the calendar year shall be published by March first (1) of the following year in accordance to Arkansas Law section 14-59-116 Semiannual Publication of Financial Statement

This amendment does not change the postings of ordinances, resolutions, bylaws of a general or permanent nature and all those imposing any fine or penalty, or forfeiture.
