

Ordinance no. 03-31
AN ORDINANCE CREATING A CITY PLANNING COMMISSION OF
THE CITY OF HIGHLAND, ARKANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF HIGHLAND, ARKANSAS:

Section 1: There is hereby created a commission of the City of Highland, Arkansas, to be known as the Highland Planning Commission, which said commission shall consist of seven members who shall serve without compensation.

Section 2: The Planning Commission shall have all the duties and functions authorized by ACT 186 of the Acts of Arkansas, 1957, as amended, codified as Arkansas code, 14-56-401, et seq.

Section 3: The members of the Planning Commission shall be recommended by the Nominating Committee and appointed by a majority vote of the City Council. Appointments will be valid and effective upon confirmation by the City Council.

Section 4: The terms of the members of the Planning Commission shall be for two years. The City Council shall designate the terms of the initial appointments. Thereafter as vacancies occur in said Commission, for whatever cause, said vacancies shall be filled in the manner provided and said appointees shall hold office until expiration of the term which they were appointed to fill.

Section 5: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; and this action being necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, prosperity, safety, order, comfort and convenience of the City of Highland, Arkansas, and the inhabitants thereof, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from the date of its adoption.
