**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO 2011-04 ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURE FOR THE SETTING OF FEES FOR INSTALLATION OF SEWER PUMPS, TANKS AND SERVICE LINES AND REQUIRED CONNECTIONS TO THE SEWER SYSTEM FACILITIES AND RE-CONNECTION FEES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Highland, Arkansas:

**Section 1.** That Ordinance No. 2011-04 is amended by adding the language of this ordinance to Section 2. Minimum Billing, to wit:

**Section 2. Minimum Billing**

**Add new subsection (d)**

(d) If a property owner notifies the City that the property will be vacant, the property owner may request that the sewer service be suspended during the term of vacancy, provided that the property remains vacant and no water service is being provided to the property. After a determination that no water service is being provided to the property, the City will suspend the sewer service. upon the payment of the sum of \$100.00 for disconnecting the sewer service. There will also be a fee of \$100.00 payable to the City to reconnect the property to the sanitary sewer system when the property is no longer vacant or water service is restored to the property.

**Section 2. Severability**

If any section of this ordinance is held to be invalid, that part shall be deemed to be severable and the invalidity thereof shall not affect the remaining sections of the ordinance.


**Emergency Clause**

In order to maintain the fiscal integrity of the sanitary sewer system operated by the City of Highland, Arkansas, and to adequately protect the public health and welfare by having a comprehensive structure for the payment of services associated with the provision of sanitary sewer system, the City Council of the City of Highland, Arkansas, has determined that an emergency exists and that this Ordinance, being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, comfort, convenience, morals, safety, and welfare of the City of Highland, Arkansas, shall be in full force and effect from the date of its adoption.
