After a determination that no water service is being provided to the property, the City will suspend the sewer service. upon the payment of the sum of \$100.00 for disconnecting the sewer service. There will also be a fee of \$100.00 payable to the City to reconnect the property to the sanitary sewer system when the property is no longer vacant or water service is restored to the property.
